



FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Cataract surgery is an elective procedure and is deemed a medical necessity if the cataract has become visually significant and affects your daily life. Most major medical insurance companies have benefits for coverage related to your cataract surgery, but the patient is responsible for deductibles, co-pays, and co-insurance. We advise patients to contact their insurance company regarding in-network and out-of-network benefits for the Surgeon, Surgery Center, and Anesthesia Fees. We will attempt to notify you if we (the Surgeon) are out of network. Still, ultimately, it is the patient's responsibility to ensure surgery payment and know their benefits.

It is important to note that the premium IOLs and the Femtosecond laser are not covered or reimbursed by any insurance companies. Listed below are the specific cataract CPT codes regarding surgery that will be used to process your claim if you would like to verify your benefits with your insurance company:
